The Romanian Government through the Ministry of Finance on behalf of the Ministry of Health has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the additional financing for Health Sector Reform – Improving Health System Quality and Efficiency Project, and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for procurement of equipment for the regional and local cancer screening centers and units (7 lots).
2. The **Ministry of Health - Project Management Unit** now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for procurement of medical equipment for the regional and local cancer screening centers and units to be delivered, installed and train the Beneficiaries technical and medical staff in 150 days after the contract signing date to 48 regional and local centers for cancer screening distributed throughout the country.
3. Bidding will be conducted through national competitive procurement using a Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank’s “Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers”, November 2020 (“Procurement Regulations”), and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.
4. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from the Project Management Unit (28C, General C-tin Budisteanu Str., 3rd floor, Sector 1, Bucharest, Romania) and inspect the bidding documents during office 10:00 to 16:00 hours local time on all working days, starting with **October 18, 2023**. A pre-bid meeting which prospective bidders may attend will be held at **12:00 hour’s local time on October 31, 2023**.
5. The bidding document in English can be requested by interested eligible bidders upon the submission of a written application to the address below. The RFB will be delivered electronically by e-mail to the prospective bidders’ representatives nominated in the written application.
6. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before **November 29, 2023, 12:00 hours local time**. Electronic Bidding will not be permitted. Late Bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the Bidders’ designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend at the address below on **November 29, 2023, 12:00 hours local time**.
7. All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid-Securing Declaration.
8. Attention is drawn to the Procurement Regulations requiring the Borrower to disclose information on the successful bidder’s beneficial ownership, as part of the Contract Award Notice, using the Beneficial Ownership Disclosure Form as included in the bidding document.
